SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY MODEL CONTEST

Rules and Regulations

1. Student from the invited schools can participate individually or in-groups of not more than two. **Individual entries may have additional points during evaluation.** Only one model from one participant/team will be accepted. Each participant/participants of one model shall fill up one entry form. Photocopies of entry form are acceptable.
2. The model shall be a **working model** and not just a model or a picture for mere viewing. The participant shall be able to explain the model to the judges/visitors and answer their queries.
3. The theme/title of the model can be on any ***Science and Technology topic.***
4. The candidate is responsible to provide the model safe for operation and that shall not cause any danger of explosion, electrocution, and health and safety hazards.
5. The candidate shall fill up the attached entry form with concise description of the model in not more than 150 words and shall submitted to the organizers before 14th September 2007 through the respective schools. The completed entry forms through the endorsement of the school should reach our office/ Attn: Mr. M.Mahendran, Tel: 36779495.
6. Final approved entries shall be intimated before 18th September 2007.
7. All required equipment, consumables are to be arranged by the participants at their own expenditure. Transporting the model to the display venue and taking them back immediately after the display is the responsibility of the participants. **Selected participants should present at the venue with their models and required accessories at 14.00 hrs on 21st September 2007. The candidates shall be responsible for the storage of their materials.**
8. The candidates shall mention clearly of any requirement from the organizers like electrical power, water, table etc., for the display of their model in the entry form.

9. The models shall be evaluated based on the originality, functionality, presentation, innovation and the ability of the candidates to answer the questions. Students from I STD to IV STD shall be in the category of **sub-juniors group**, V STD to VIII STD shall be in **junior group** and those IX STD to XII STD will be in **senior group**. Three winners in each group will be declared and given prizes. All participants will receive a certificate of participation. Organizers and the judges' decision on the results will be final.
10. Students should not present themselves in their school uniform, which may lead to disqualifications.
